CHRISTMAS FAYRE

The PSA are very busy organising the Christmas Fair, which is to be held in school on **Friday 7th December from 3.45 p.m. to 5.30 p.m.**, and would like your help with donations if possible. On the following days the children will be able to come to school in non-uniform in exchange for a donation, as follows:

Friday 30th November

KS1 to bring a £1 donation which we can use to buy prizes for some of the activities and stalls.

KS2 to bring bottles of unopened toiletries or drinks for the bottle tombola.

Wednesday 5th December

Children to bring into school a present for the 'Mystery Christmas Present' stall. This should be a present with a value of approximately £2.00. It should be wrapped and labelled to indicate if it is suitable for a man, woman, boy or girl, and the age the present is suitable for if it is a child's present.

Christmas Cupcake Competition - We will be holding a Christmas themed cupcake competition. If your child would like to enter the competition we ask that they bring in 4 cupcakes with a Christmas theme on the morning of **Friday 7th December**. The cupcakes will be displayed, judged and then put on our cake stall to sell. There will be a £10 gift voucher awarded as a 1st prize and two runners-up prizes of chocolate.

Cake Stall - We would be very grateful for any donations of small cakes or mince pies for our cake stall. These can be handed in to school from **Tuesday 4th December**.

Toys & Books - During the **week beginning 3rd December** we would also be very grateful for any donations of good quality second-hand toys and books.

Entrance to the fair will be **50p per adult and children go free**.

If they would like to, children will be allowed to wear their Christmas jumpers on the day of the fair to get us all in the Christmas spirit.

All proceeds go to our 'Inspired Play' playground development project.

POPUK C.D.

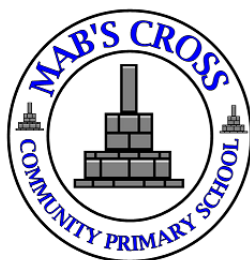
We still have a few copies of the POPUK C.D. recorded by the children earlier this term. If you would like to purchase a copy please send in **£8.00** in a labelled envelope.
