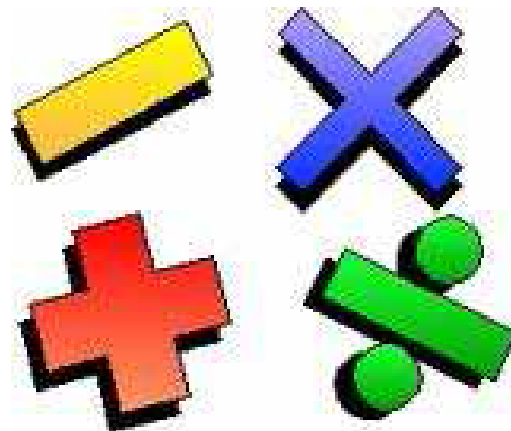


Maths Targets Year 1

The Maths Curriculum

Maths is split into three main areas these are **Number, Measurement and Geometry**.

The new curriculum is much more challenging:

- Higher expectations for reading and writing numerals to 100
- Knowledge of all addition and subtraction number bonds to 20
- Vocabulary associated with addition and subtraction.

We assess the children against the "Age Related Expectations".

This booklet aims to provide you with the information to show you what your child is expected to achieve in each of these three areas by the end of Year 1. It clearly shows the learning objectives we will be assessing against throughout the year.

Number Targets

- I can count reliably to 100.
- I can count on and back in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s from any given number up to 100.
- I can write all numbers in words to 20.
- I can say the number that is one more or one less than a number to 100.
- I can recall all pairs of addition and subtraction number bonds to 20.
- I can add and subtract 1-digit and 2-digit numbers to 20, including zero.
- I know the signs + - =.
- I can solve a missing number problem e.g. $20 - ? = 14$
- I can solve a one-step problem using addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations.



Measurement and Geometry Targets

- I can tell the time to o'clock and half past the hour.
- I can name the days of the week and months of the year.
- I can recognise and name the 3D shapes: cuboid, pyramid, sphere.
- I can recognise and name the 2D shapes: circle, triangle, square and rectangle.
- I can recognise all coins.
