Priority	Description
1.	Improve attainment and progress in mathematics across all phases of the school.
	 Develop a 'differentiated input' approach to the teaching of mathematics that addresses the needs of all pupils. Weekly basic skills maths tests and high quality follow-up teaching ensuring all pupils develop a deeper understanding of key mathematical concepts.
2.	Raise attainment in reading and writing across school.
	 Consistent approaches to guided reading and writing. Introduce blogging to motivate pupils to write to a higher standard and to offer pupils a real audience.
3.	Improve the provision and outcomes for pupils with SEND (Special Educational Needs & Disability).
	To fully implement the new Code of Practice for SEND and communicate the local SEND offer to all parents and carers.
	Ensure high quality support is in place for all pupils on the school's SEND register.
4.	Improve the effectiveness of the Governing Body.
	 Ensure that Governors are well-informed about all aspects of school life, especially academic achievement. Effectively challenge and support senior leaders in school, especially in English and mathematics.
